



### **What the course will involve -**

This course is the equivalent to two A Levels and is studied over two years.

Initially you will develop a solid dance technique and then apply this to a range of dance styles such as Contemporary dance, World Dance and Urban Dance.

You will also develop skills in Choreography and Dance Appreciation.

You will take part in a range of performances in college, which will be a major part of your assessment.

## Assessment -

Over the 2 years you will be assessed in various ways.

Performance is a large part of the assessment criteria, and you will perform in numerous shows over the two years, showcasing many different dance styles.

You will also be assessed on coursework, which includes producing performance log books, choreographic notes, health & fitness plans and CV/audition material.

This course can lead to a variety of paths in dance and the performing arts such as higher education and performing. These can lead to careers in the performing and production of the arts, teaching, dance therapy, community dance work and choreography.



## Entry Requirements -

5 GCSEs grade C or above.
