This course will give you a flying start if you know you want to do A Level Sciences and especially if you need high grades for medicine, dentistry or veterinary sciences.

The entry requirements for this course are

- a level 6 at KS3 science
- a record showing that homework and class work is completed consistently
- an attendance above 92%
- good or excellent for effort on the OMR grades

Course Description

- 2 year course – You will study Core Science in Year 10 plus additional topics for each subject in Year 11.
- 3 separate GCSEs awarded.
- Practical assessment and theory work.

Assessment

Each GCSE has:

- 30% 2 module tests (for each science subject) in Year 10
- 20% Assessed Practical Work
- 50% Terminal exams in Year 11
