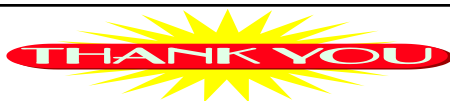

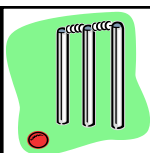


The three students are: **Lewis Henshall Y11, Jessica Murphy Y7, Anthony Choi Y10,**
