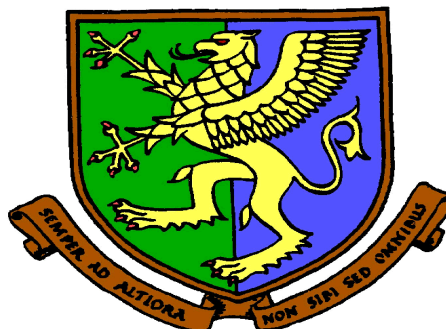

HPV Immunisation Programme - Good News

You will be aware that the HPV immunisation programme was launched in October 2008. In St. Helens, girls in year 8 were offered the three HPV injections in all secondary schools. We are pleased to say that the school programme has been a huge success with a high percentage of year 8 girls receiving all three doses.

If any year 8 girl was absent for any of the HPV injections the school nurse will know about it and will offer the catch up doses either in school or in a clinic setting before the end of the school academic year.

We must congratulate everyone who was involved in the local programme; much of the credit for the high uptake must go to parents/carers for supporting the programme, the girls for attending sessions, schools for accommodating the team and the school health nursing team for delivering it.

Year 8 girls will continue to be offered the HPV injection year on year. However, we are now very pleased to say that an accelerated HPV catch up programme has been announced. The accelerated programme will result in girls and young women being offered protection against cervical cancer earlier than expected.

From September 2009, girls in year 10 and year 11 will be offered the HPV vaccine in school and girls born between 1st September 1991 and 31st August 1993 will be offered the injection at their GP surgery.

The school health nursing team will soon be arranging dates in St. Helens secondary schools so they can begin planning the sessions for next year. Please wait to receive an information pack and a consent form, then sign and return it to Cowley, Information sessions will be held for parents/carers for girls.

It is still essential for young women who have been immunised to take part in the cervical screening programme once they are old enough.
