Easter Masterclasses



Over the Easter holidays, we will be running some Masterclasses for students to help them prepare for their upcoming exams. There will be two weeks of masterclasses, which will be a chance for students to put the extra work in and help them to reach their target grade. Week 1 will be a full week of GCSE masterclasses while Week 2 will be a short week of vocational masterclasses with two masterclasses held each day from 10:00am-2:30pm. Students will each receive a bespoke timetable with masterclasses designed for them. Lunch will be provided every day, while students can wear their own clothes. We hope that all students will take advantage of these extra sessions.

Revision Resources

Year 11 students have the opportunity to study Maths and English during a Period 6 on a Monday and Thursday from 3:05pm-4:05pm. This period is compulsory for a selected cohort of students. This opportunity allows students to develop subject knowledge and their understanding of subject specific exam techniques. It has been extremely beneficial to previous year groups. As well as the excellent revision opportunities we offer as a school, the Year 11 students have also been given revision books for each GCSE subject; retrieval logs that have been proven to be the most effective way of revising; as well as access to GCSE POD.
