


### Dear Parent/Carer,

We have already started to implement some new procedures and I am proud of how the students are responding to these changes.




From September, Cowley will operate slightly differently as we continue to align our routines with our core priorities. Please take note of the following updates:



## **Structure of the School Day**

- The school day will now begin at **8:30am**, with Period 1 starting at 8:35am.
- Team Time and assemblies will move to later in the morning.
- Our free breakfast offer continues students are welcome to join us from 8:15am.





#### Year 11 Breakfast Boost

Our successful Year 11 Breakfast Boost will continue. Year 11 students are welcome to attend the library from **8:00am** for independent study. This was a valuable part of many students' revision routines this year and will remain a key support initiative.





#### **Break and Lunchtime Arrangements**

- Break and lunchtimes will now be staggered across year groups. This change will help reduce queuing times and improve supervision and behaviour.
- Students will be allocated zoned areas to enjoy their social time while ensuring other lessons can continue undisturbed.
- Lunchtime will be reduced to 30 minutes, as shorter queues mean students can eat and relax in less time. The current 50-minute lunch has led to issues in the final part of the period, which we aim to reduce.

# **End of the Day and Enrichment**

- Period 5 will finish at **2:45pm**, and school bus times have been adjusted.
- Our broad and exciting enrichment programme will return in September, running on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, some Thursdays, and Fridays from **2:50pm** until **3:50pm**.
- These enrichment activities are free of charge and an essential part of our commitment to personal development. We expect all students to participate in at least one enrichment per week.
- Once students have chosen their enrichment activities during the first half term, these
  will be included into their timetables for parents to monitor their child's attendance
  and participation via the MCAS app.
- Year 11 students will be directed to academic enrichment sessions, which will also appear on their timetables and enable the students to achieve in their GCSE exams.

#### **Detentions**

A small number of students may receive detentions as part of our behaviour policy. These will be either 30, 60 or 90 minutes, depending on the nature of the behaviour issue. Detentions will be held the day after the detention is logged.
