Open Evening, 4.00 - 7.00pm



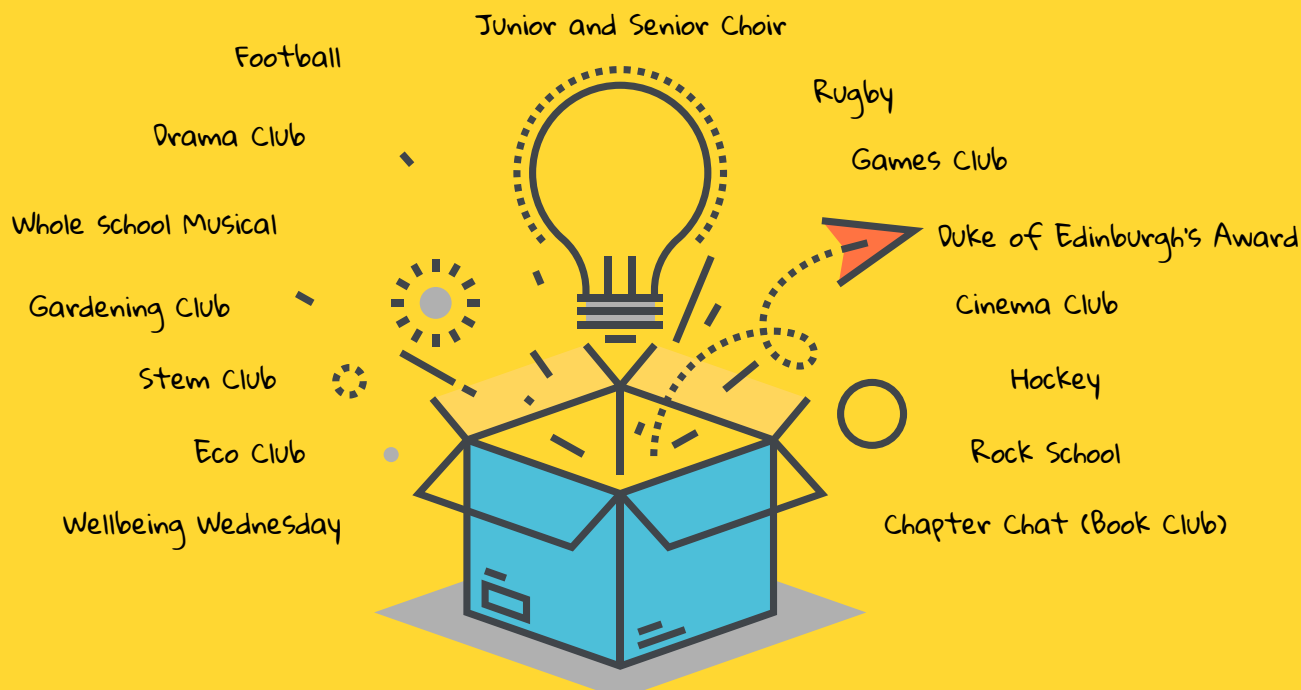
Next Thursday, we open the doors to Year 5 and Year 6 for our annual Open Evening.
