# ALL WORK must be recorded on to appropriately decorated work sheets in the portfolio.

#### **OBSERVATIONAL STUDIES:**

Select objects - choose and record objects with a variety of textures and shapes using photography - natural and electrical lights, directional and non-directional lighting.

#### **OBSERVATIONAL** STUDIES:

Select objects related to the project - choose objects with a variety of textures and shapes. Use 9H - 9B pencils to record different textures an form.

### **OBSERVATIONAL** STUDIES:

Annotate your work: Explain the reason for choosing objects and describe which process/technique vou have used in creating your best result.

#### COLOUR:

Select ideas/objects. select an image or an area using viewfinder, enlarge and use acrylics/watercolour/inks to create an accurate representation.

#### COMPOSITION:

Use your artists'/cultures' ideas to create your own, individual compositions remember foreground, middle-ground, background, leading lines etc when composing.

#### **EXPERIMENTATION:**

Compose your images using processes from previous learning employ collage, textures, 3D or computer-aided imagery.

#### **CULTURE:**

From your research, find all appropriate artistic aspects of your chosen culture. Identify their importance in your work read and learn about the culture.

Look at artist's or culture's (A) work research what, how, why and when their work was created.
