A letter was sent home (via Class Charts) and is also available on our website, detailing the plan for next Tuesday.

The plan is different to the first strike day. Below is a snippet of the key details, but please refer to the letter for all the information.

Next Tuesday, 28th February, the College will only be open to Sixth Form, Y11 students and a small group of identified Y7-10 students. Sixth Form students will follow their normal timetable.

Year 11 students will complete their English and Maths GCSE rehearsal exams during P1-4 and then leave the site at approximately 1pm to complete exam study at home. Year 11 students will arrive at 8.30am, in full uniform, and register with the year team in the canteen.
