## APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES AT ARNOLD CLARK WIGAN

Currently advertising several apprenticeship positions at Arnold Clark Wigan for a September start, including vehicle mechanics (technicians), but also customer service / aftersales advisors. Arnold Clark

The customer service apprenticeships incorporate a Digital Application Support SCQF Level 6 qualification, so are ideal for students interested in progressing into data processing, web or multimedia applications or helpdesk application support.

The apprentice hourly rate is £7.25 per hour, increasing with experience. Other benefits include 33 days' holiday, private healthcare, paid driving lessons and 2x funded attempts at the driving test.

Students who are on track to achieve GCSE grade 4+ in Maths and English + one other subject (which must be science for the technicians) will be considered. An online Maths and English assessment will be undertaken with applicants in lieu of them receiving their GCSE results.

The vacancies can be viewed and applied for by clicking the apply here button below – please be aware that some training will be held in Glasgow, so applicants must be comfortable with travelling on the train and staying in a hotel without parental support – all related travel costs, accommodation and food will be paid for by Arnold Clark during this time.
