650 MPs sit here, it makes laws, questions the government and examines what it is doing. It also keeps a check on the amount of money that government spends.

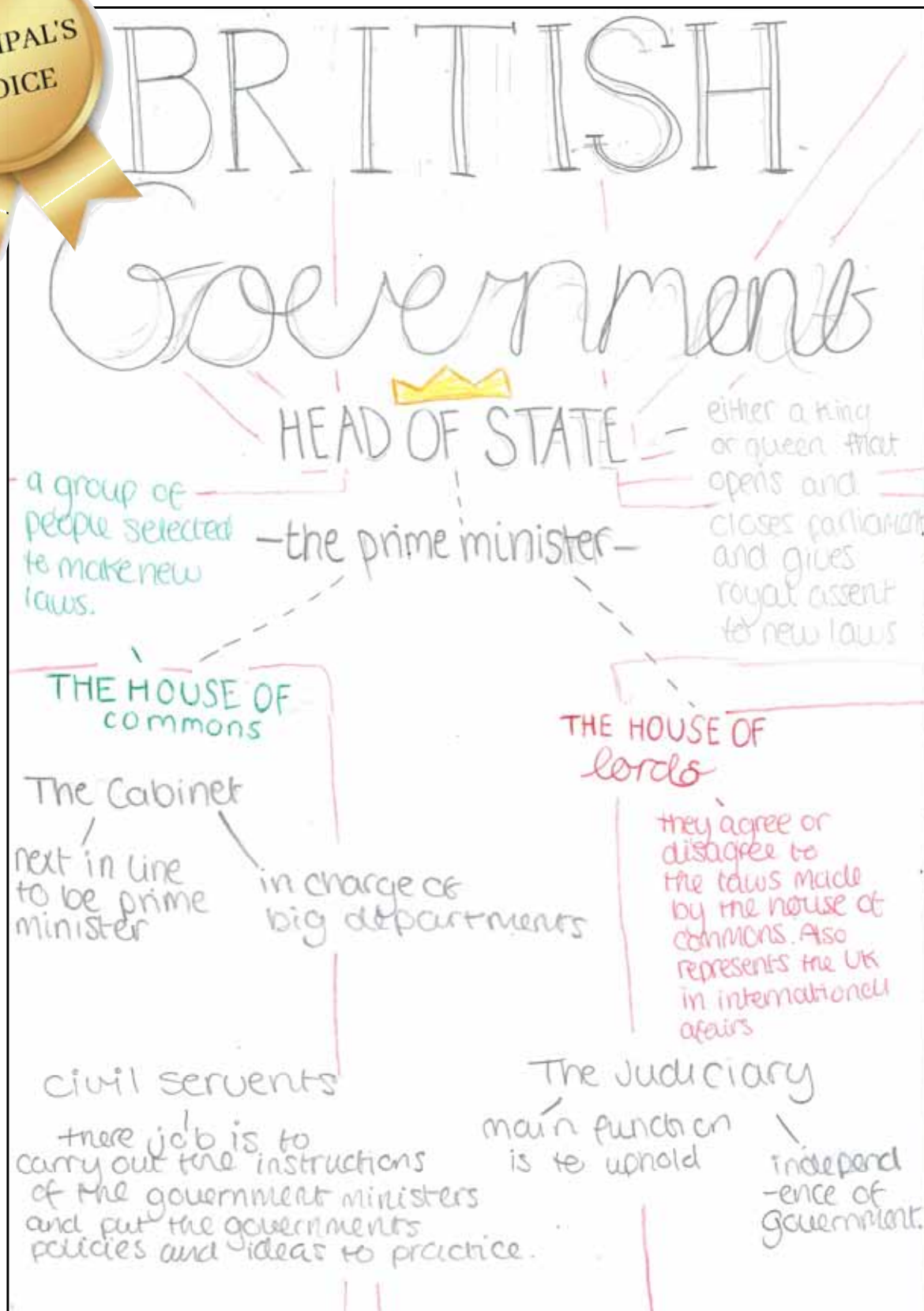
THE HOUSE OF LORDS
