Open Evening



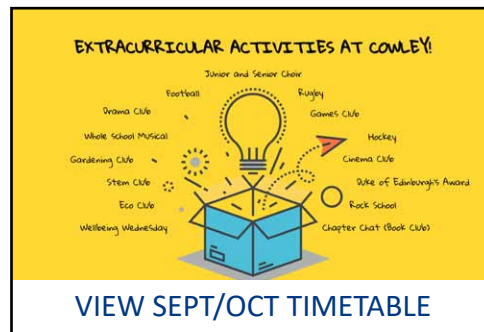
