

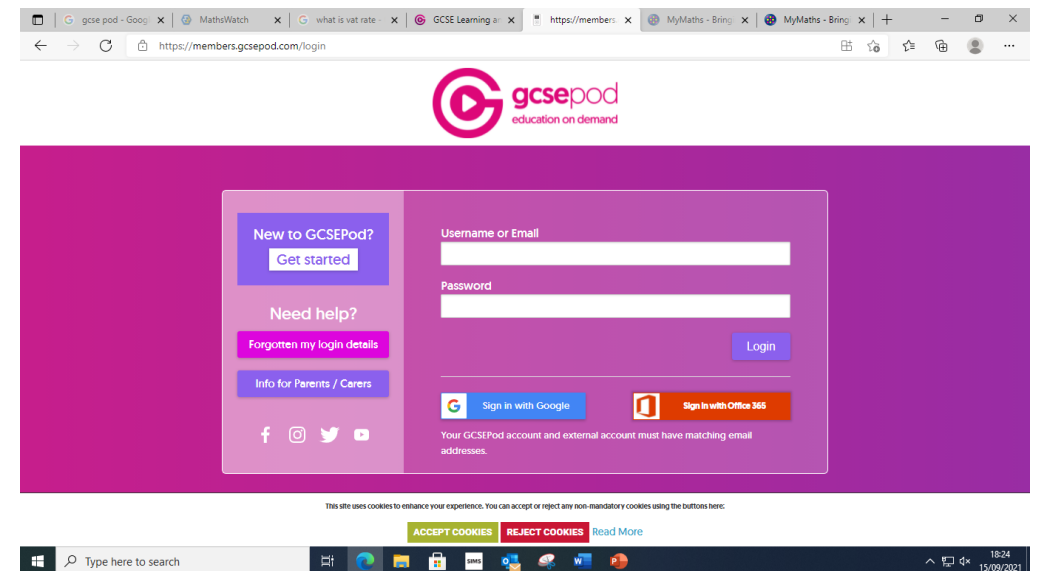

- If they forget their username they must ask a teacher or Mr Acton to reset

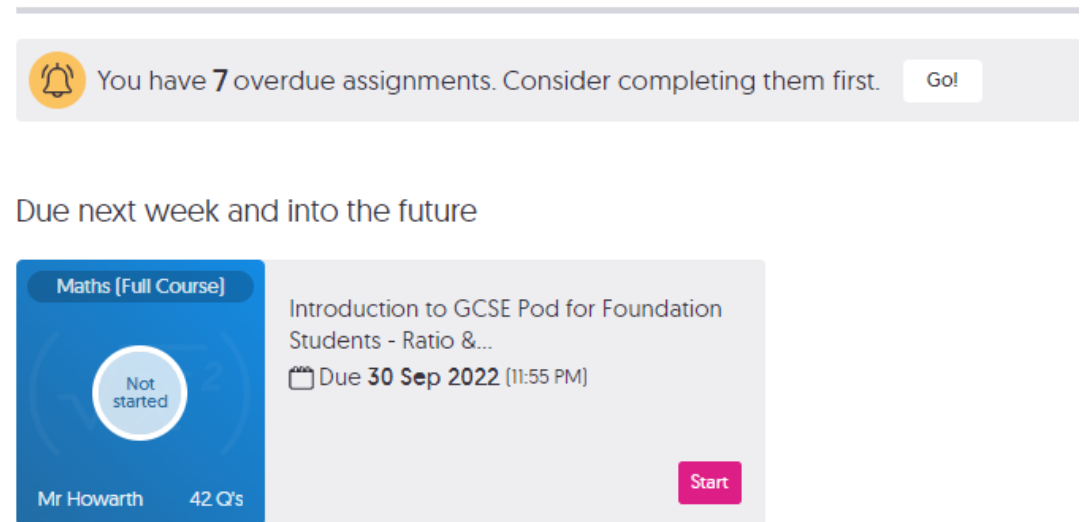


How does it work
