

CAREERS IN THE CANTEEN

SIXTH FORM STUDENTS RECEIVE SUPPORT FROM EMPLOYERS & UNIVERSITIES

This half term has seen Cowley Sixth Form College launch a new Careers event, 'Careers in the Canteen'.

'Careers In The Canteen' is a bi-weekly 'drop in' event which takes place in one of the busiest areas of Cowley Sixth Form College, the canteen, where by employers, higher education institutions and apprenticeship providers are invited come into college, set up a stand and are able to speak to our students about careers opportunities in an informal setting.

Students are able to stop by at any time over the 2-hour session to gather information and advice about internships, university courses, work experience, apprenticeship places and much more from our visitors.

Sessions will take place on selected Friday afternoons, from 12:15-2:15pm.

The first session was held on Friday 2nd February with James from the **Bethell Group** attending to chat with our students about careers and apprenticeships in construction and engineering and all the opportunities currently available with the company.

James, who is a former Cowley student, said: "It was really good to speak to the students and inform them of the options and opportunities available."

Over the next few weeks, we will have other employers from different industry sectors, as well as higher education institutions, visiting the College as part of 'Careers in the Canteen' and giving our students access to key careers information.
