





# Student attendance is important

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notices issued after the 19th August 2024.

# Per parent, per child

Penalty Notice Fines will now be issued to **each parent**, for **each child** that was absent.

For example, 3 siblings absent for term time leave would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

## £160 per parent, per child, paid within

First offence

amount will be:

28 days.

Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for

term time leave or irregular attendance, the

# 5 consecutive days of term time leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more days.

10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10-week period.

### Second offence (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular attendance, the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child, paid within 28 days.

# Third offence and any further offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for term time leave or irregular attendance, a Penalty Notice will not be issued and the case will be considered for prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Magistrates' fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.
