## Communication change

We've now fully transitioned from ClassCharts to Bromcom (MyChildAtSchool app) to enhance how we manage and communicate student information.

Attendance is now tracked through this system and is no longer visible on ClassCharts. ClassCharts will still be used for behaviour logs, achievement points, and for reporting absences or submitting medical evidence.
