**Parents Evening appointments will be made via the My Child at School App (MCAS). Bookings will open on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2026 and we will close the system on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2026 at 9.00am.**



The system is user-friendly and allows you to choose your appointment time with your child's teachers. Once you have logged into MCAS, simply click on the Parents Evening section and your child's subjects will appear so you can book the individual appointments. If you do not have access to MCAS please contact the college who will help in sending you the details to activate your account.



Please be aware that some teachers handle multiple classes, which may limit the number of appointments available. As a result, bookings will be allocated on a first come, first-served basis. We encourage you to log in and secure your appointments as soon as possible to ensure you can meet with the teachers you wish to speak with. We look forward to welcoming you then.

In addition to subject teachers, other key staff will be available to discuss any issues or concerns you may have. This includes Mrs Foster (College Manager), Mrs MacKay (SENCO), and myself.
