Year 12 Parents' Conference

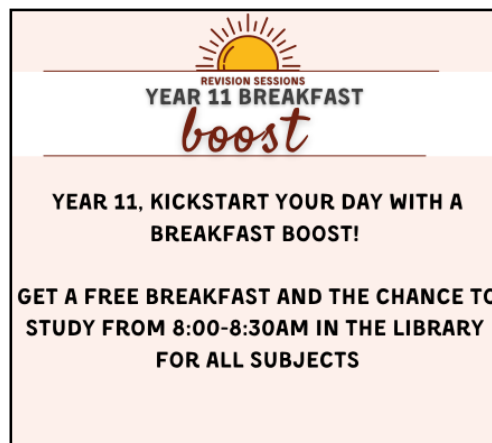
